The **European Higher Education Week** (EHEW) is organised by the EU Delegation to Vietnam and EU Member States in **#TeamEurope** approach. Participation is open to Higher education institutions and Embassies from the 27 EU Member States.

About Vietnam:

Vietnam is a **thriving market** with **untapped potential**. Its rapidly expanding middle class, with a remarkable annual growth rate of **17%**, fuels a significant demand for quality international education. There are also over **21 million** individuals **aged 15-29** in Vietnam. Vietnamese families invest approximately **USD 4 billion annually** in overseas education, demonstrating a strong commitment to global learning experiences. Meanwhile, Europe is increasingly becoming a preferred destination for Vietnamese students across diverse disciplines and academic levels. Currently, around **40,000** Vietnamese students are pursuing their studies and research in Europe.

Within Erasmus+, the EU's flagship education, training, youth, and sports program, Vietnam has made notable achievements. During 2014-2024, approx. **3,700 Vietnamese students and staff** moved to Erasmus+33 countries for short-term exchanges. Meanwhile, **96 capacity-building projects** involving Vietnamese universities received Erasmus+ funding.

Horizon Europe, the world's largest research and innovation program, also witnesses Vietnam's active participation in **15 projects** and the funding of nearly **1.2 million euros** during 2021 - 2024. In the predecessor Horizon 2020, Vietnam received **2.9 million euros** and got involved in **35 projects** during 2014 - 2020.
